James about to get some mail when he just called - he picked me up at 7:45 & we arrived at the Te at 8⁰⁰

As we were entering, several things were said both in voice & in text & in pictures - he was generally reacting to the testimony - also being given at the time with the parade-disc & felt & other with a sense of what she he devoted to honor & service for
