

19 Feb - Su

We were not awakened until an hr  
late today

I had sleep at 8:00

It had on my mind all morn, writing  
my reactions to the day of crisis, 16 Feb  
Went to the Central Area around 12:00 -

guests from the Guy govt. were expected -  
I joined Harriet Tropp who had a demon-  
stration class for adults, since it was  
Su, on Guyanese history

Two govt. officials were in the party,  
Fred Hills, the former Jorin Min. who  
was said to have been deposed but  
who according to Dick Tropp later in the  
day, may still be Jorin Min., & the  
Min of Ed, Vincent Teekah - Teekah  
stayed in Port Kaituma until later in the  
day

Hills did not notice our class at all.  
The party, w/ his leadership, went  
directly to the Pavilion where they con-  
ferred - we were released - Teekah  
arrived by 1:00 & he had he wanted  
to inspect our site - I was worried

that he might want to see our sch  
records, some of which I have &  
which are far from complete - I have  
done nothing on them - however  
Harriet told me later that Teekah was  
impressed w/our project & that all went  
well

I had asked Dick for a list of the  
govt ministers - the pres. is Arthur  
Chung, Chin - Forbes Burnham is Prime  
Min., Ptolemy Reid the Dep'ty Prime  
Min.; Vincent Teekah, Min. of Ed., for  
Min. Fred Wills; & Desmond Hoyt, Min.  
of Developm

I ret'd to the cottage & rd till until  
dinner.

Went to dinner at 5<sup>00</sup> - the line was  
not too bad - we had liver, sweet potatoes  
& ground

Got my cooky around 7<sup>00</sup> - the band &  
singers were furnishing entertainment in  
the pavilion until late but I stayed for  
just a few mins.

Went until bedtime in the cottage -  
Diana, Verne & the child were in the  
cottage but I was on w/my girl, etc

19 Feb - Su - 2

That I helped sweep out the cottage  
when V. borrowed a brown

Beane seemed very depressed all  
day which I think was a result of the  
adverse comment on her permissiveness  
in yesterday's entry - I tried to soothe her feel-  
ings but she did not respond, maybe  
because it might have been interpreted  
as gossiping or resentment of authority.

On Su evenings it takes a long time  
for the cottage crew to settle down for  
child, to be taken back to their homes  
& residents to turn off their tape recorders.  
altho the guards had announced "Lights Out"  
at 11<sup>00</sup> so usual - Laura Johnston, who has  
moved into the left, had a severe  
arrhythmia during the night & also intended  
to use Karamitov in the next cottage  
when she got from her severe arrhythmia

I had gone to bed at 11<sup>00</sup>  
11<sup>15</sup> I saw Jim Bogue on ret. from my  
shower & questioned him on some charges  
in the Bogue & Cordell families - J. is not  
called Jim Howell - Edith Bogue is not the  
companion of Harold Cordell, who the her  
name, Bogue - Tina is the companion of Bruce  
Turner, & Marilyn is the companion of Cordell
