My mother, Rita Tupper, walked out to use the bathroom, she tripped over her long dress, and fell down the stairs, splitting her head open, and immediately died. One of the nurses ran up to Pastor Jones and told him that she was dead. He said, "bring her to me." They brought her right up to the stage, Pastor Jones touched her on the head and told her to arise. She got right up and started running around the building thanking him for the healing she received.
